CAMP INVENTION FOR GRADES K-5

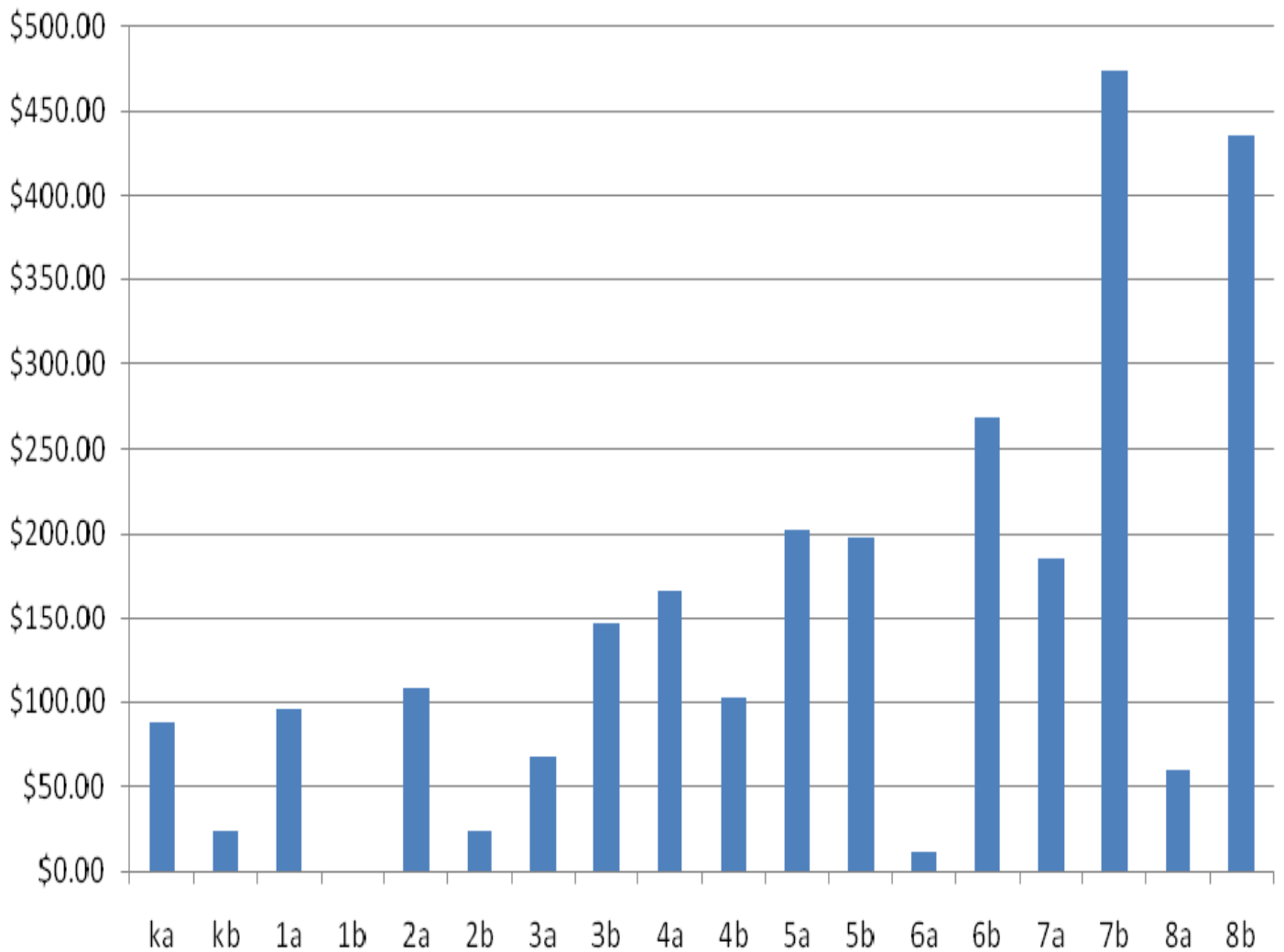
